

Uniform Requirements

All students in Years 7 - 12 must wear school uniform. Year 13 students do not have to wear School Uniform with the exception of formal school occasions, but must dress neatly and appropriately for a work environment and their feet must be covered. The Year 13 Dress Code will be negotiated annually with the Year 13 cohort.

Tolcarne co-ordinates the second-hand uniform pool for St Hilda's Collegiate School and sells clothing on a commission basis. All items for sale must be of good quality (ie: able to last a minimum of one year continuous use) and dry cleaned. (Items that are not clean will be dry cleaned and the cost deducted from the sale proceeds). House Managers will advise on prices that are fair and likely to sell.

The Uniform Pool is open one week prior to the beginning of school and other times by appointment. Please telephone (03) 464-0074 in advance to ensure a staff member is available to assist you. The times at the beginning of the year will be notified in the School newsletters in Term 4.

Tolcarne also has a small pool of uniform items for short term hire. Any donations of uniforms for this purpose would be gratefully accepted.

Formal Uniform (Compulsory)

School woollen kilt (ordered made to measure from Tudor Clothing, 455 Princes St, Dunedin) Blazer (H&J Smith)

Long sleeved, white, pointed collar blouse (H&J Smith) Junior/Senior tie (School Office)

Short, plain white ankle socks

Black, hard leather lace up shoes. This does not include skate 'leather type' shoes that may be sold as school shoes or non lace up shoes

Compulsory Items (additional)

School summer kilt (H&J Smith)
Regulation Backpack (School Office)
Bucket Hat (School Office)
Short sleeved, white, pointed collar blouse (H&J Smith)

Summer Uniform is worn in Terms 1 and 4. Winter Uniform is worn Terms 2 and 3 and may be worn at any time. Winter Uniform is worn for all formal occasions.

ALL ITEMS MUST BE CLEARLY NAMED.

General

St Hilda's badges or representative badges may be worn on the blazer. Hair if collar length or longer must be tied back with plain hair coloured elastic or black or blue hair ties. Hair must not be conspicuously tinted or bleached and must be neat at all times. Ribbons, if worn, are to be light blue, or school tartan. Black/brown tortoiseshell hair clips or hair bands may be worn.

For pierced ears, a maximum of two plain gold or silver studs may be worn per ear. No other jewellery of any type is to be worn other than a watch. Conspicuous makeup is not permitted. No nail polish is to be worn.

NOTE: It is the obligation of all parents to see that their daughter leaves home in the morning clean and tidy in the regulation uniform.
