SCHOOL TUITION FEE

School tuition fee covers the provision of full time tuition (25 lessons per week) including specialist English Language classes. The short-stay tuition fee (one term or less) is \$570 per week. Senior students who choose to study the New Zealand NCEA qualification in Years 12 and 13, will pay the NCEA examination fee separately. The school tuition fee also includes the school's Board of Proprietors attendance levy, as St Hilda's Collegiate is a state-integrated school.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Students who will attend St Hilda's for more than one year, will need to buy their full formal school uniform on arrival (approximately \$700) from the NZ Uniform Shop. Students who will attend for one year or less, can choose to hire the formal school uniform and PE uniform from the school (\$150-\$400). All students regardless of their length of study are expected to purchase their own St Hilda's school shirts.

HOMESTAY FEE

The school carefully selects host families within our school and local community to provide a welcoming and caring family environment, pastoral care and full board. The homestay fee is \$360 per week. All host family adults are police-vetted and host families must comply with the New Zealand Code of Compliance for hosting an international student.

DISBURSEMENT DEPOSIT

The disbursement deposit is contingency money used to pay accounts incurred by students during the time they are studying at St Hilda's Collegiate School. These accounts may include items such as additional uniform items, sports fees and events, orchestral instrument hire, school trips, daily bus fares, school stationery, subject fees and New Zealand NCEA qualification examination fees. Additional funds may need to be provided if the student or student's family have requested the school to organise private lessons for music, language or sport tuition.

UNUSED FUNDS

Any funds remaining in the student's homestay and disbursement deposit accounts will be refunded to the student's parents following the completion of their education with St Hilda's Collegiate School.
